RE: SB 922 (Wiener) Signature Request

Dear Governor Newsom:

The American Planning Association, California Chapter (APA California) respectfully requests that you sign SB 922, which builds upon previous efforts in SB 288 (Wiener) [Chapter 200, Statutes of 2020]. Importantly, SB 922 would modify and extend the statutory exemptions to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for clean transportation projects, established by SB 288. In addition, the bill will provide clarity for implementation purposes and stronger protections for risks against displacement, among many other changes.

APA California is a non-profit organization made up of practicing planners, citizens and public officials committed to advancing the practice of local, regional, and statewide planning throughout urban, suburban, and rural California. Our organization supports efforts to create sustainable communities that help meet California's overall climate goals. Likewise, APA California is supportive of the streamlining offered in SB 922 to develop sustainable transportation projects at a time when it is critical to address greenhouse gas emissions in our communities, particularity those from the transportation sector.
