NEUTRAL – AS PROPOSED TO BE AMENED

Dear Senator Portantino:

The California State Association of Counties (CSAC), the League of California Cities (Cal Cities), the Urban Counties of California (UCC), the California Chapter of the American Planning Association (APA California), and the Rural County Representatives of California (RCRC) have removed our opposition to your Senate Bill 932 based on the proposed amendments August 25, 2022.

As agreed, the proposed amendments make clarifying and technical amendments to include specific principles included in the Federal Highway Administration's Safe System Approach; ensure goals and implementation are subject to local conditions and funding; incorporate specific projects in implementation plans rather than the General Plan; and remove inapplicable references to the Transportation Agency's Zero Traffic Fatalities Task Force Report, the State Local partnership Program, the Surface Transportation Block Grant, and the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program.
