Notice of NEUTRAL Position (As Amended on June 25, 2026)

Dear Chair Bryan,

The League of California Cities (Cal Cities), the California State Association of Counties (CSAC), the Rural County Representatives of California (RCRC), and the American Planning Association of California (APA) respectfully submit our **Neutral** position on **SB 1075 (Reyes)**, related to community emission reduction programs and plans, and land use decisions.

With the June 25 amendments, our organizations are removing our Oppose Unless Amended position and are now Neutral on the bill in print. We appreciate the author removing the broad, ongoing obligations for cities and counties to align land use decisions to the single indicator of air quality, for all commercial and industrial local planning, zoning, and permitting decisions. Cities and counties already plan and make land use decisions consistent with a plethora of environmental laws, including the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), where air quality impacts are analyzed, along with other environmental indicators. By removing this additional analysis and required findings will reduce overly burdensome and potentially duplicative analyses and reduce potential litigation risk for local governments.

For these reasons, Cal Cities, CSAC, RCRC, and APA are now **Neutral** on **SB 1075 (Reyes)**.
